

PARTICIPANT POLICIES

CICOES Research Experience for Undergraduates

Behavior/Performance

- You will follow the Participant Code of Conduct. You are to treat all others with dignity and respect. Bullying and inappropriate behavior are grounds for dismissal from the program.
- You are expected to be productive during your 35-hour workweek. If you do not know what to work on, then ask your mentor, research team, peers, or other CICOES staff for guidance.

Absences/Tardiness

- Your mentor or a contact delegated by your mentor must approve planned absences ahead of time.
- You must alert your mentor or a contact delegated by your mentor of unplanned absences or tardiness before the start of your shift or as soon as possible.
- No call, no show is unacceptable except during emergencies. If this occurs multiple times, it is grounds for dismissal from the program.
- Excessive absences or tardiness are grounds for dismissal from the program.

Technology/Equipment

- Unless specifically granted, do not use university or federal technology/equipment for personal purposes.
- Unless specifically granted, do not leave your workplace with university or federal technology/equipment.
- Theft or inappropriate use of university or federal technology/equipment are grounds for dismissal from the program and may be grounds for criminal investigation.

Dress Code

 While you are not required to wear business or business casual attire, you are expected to dress appropriately for a professional environment. For example, avoid clothing with offensive graphics or text, and refrain from wearing overly casual clothing, such as pajamas, beachwear, workout clothes, etc.
